

III CHERIAN (Kunju)

Born 1810. Residence at Morkulangara, the north eastern part of central town (Kavala) and near the S.B. College, Changanacherry. The house was situated in a plain single plot of six acres of land facing east towards a branch road reaching the M.C.Road. The old fashioned house was very spacious with ara (wooden granary), pura (house), nalukettu (projection to four sides), nadumuttam (central or inner courtyard) and padippura (wooden gate with a tiny roof of tiles). It was in this plot that the famous Ruby Rubber Works was later installed by Kunchamma Marattukalam and his brothers. When Ruby Rubber factory was developing, Ruby Thommachan demolished this ancient house and in its place a modern concrete building was constructed. Kunju and his younger son Joseph (Kunjappi, the younger) lived in that ancient house until their death. Unlike his brothers, he resorted to farming only, that is, he had no business orientation. He cultivated in lump-sum or on a large scale paddy, coconut, rubber, spices and etc. and thereby earned a lot of income and attained a high social status. This status was exposed in his amazing flocks of cattle as buffalos, cows, sheep and etc. maintained and protected for the sake of his large scale agricultural efforts. This ancestral attachment and interest towards agriculture shown by this forefather can be seen perpetuated in his succeeding generations.

He was one among the top most land lords of the town at that time; having 80 plots of land in addition to the vast areas of paddy fields. Among his contemporaries was a famous land lord in Changanacherry Known as Rajappan Muthalali, Son of the Famous Land Lord Muthupattar (A Brahmin). It was a telling truth that Kunju was at par with Rajappan Muthalali as a land lord. Only five rupees tax payers were eligible to vote for the Praja-Sabha (peoples assembly) of the erst-while Travencore Kingdom. Kunju was one among the few who enjoyed this voting right which was bequeathed to his next generation.

Kunju was handsome and gigantic in appearance. He had an honourable position in society. It was said that he possessed a very strict and serious exterior. He was able to tackle all social problems cropping up in the locality around him with an exceptional commanding power and enlightenment.

At first he married Mariamma, daughter of Ouseph, Arackal house, Kavalam, Kuttanadu. On her death, he married Thresia, Karthikapallil house, Vettithurthu, Changanacherry. It was Thresia's second marriage too. She was first married to one Mathai, Kootummel, Changanacherry. It is noteworthy that her only daughter in that marriage was married to Kunjachan (Kaniyamchira Kunjachan), the elder son of Kunju in his first marriage. Children: Two sons and two daughters in the first marriage; and one son and two daughters in the second marriage. Expired 1899.

III A1 SCARIA (Kanianchira Kunjachan)

Born 1831. Residence at Poovakkattuchira, Morkulangara; keeping the tradition he built a house with ara, pura, and padippura. He inherited vast landed proper-

ties and paddy fields. Thus he devoted his life to agriculture. He became immensely rich. He was less talkative; very bold and daring. He married Annamma, daughter of Mathai, Koottummel, as already mentioned above. Children: One son and seven daughters. Expired 1918.

III A2 OUSEPH (Ouseph)

Born 1854. Residence at Mattom, western part of Kavala, close to St. Mary's Cathedral and the present police quarters. Then, there was an already built house of his father. He was a farmer. He had as his share, nine plots of land. Also he possessed six acres of paddy fields in Paral area. He started a business in hill produces with Pala and Ponkunnam centers and achieved good progress. He was known for his shrewdness and hard working nature. He first married Aley, the sister of the famous Pullukat Kunjomman. On her death he remarried Mariamma, Chakkalayilaya Nalukandathil family, Kurumbanadom. This Mariamma was first sent in marriage to the family of Kattakkayam, Pala. Children: One son and one daughter in the first marriage; and four sons and four daughters in the second marriage. Expired 1922.

III A3 OUSEPH (Kochukunjappy)

Born 1858. Residence at family house (Tharavadu) at Morkulangara. He was known as Morkulanagara Kochukunjappy. He inherited abundant landed properties and paddy fields. Moreover, he bought additional lands of his own. He was handsome, tall (more than 6 feet) but lean and healthy. He was short tempered and adventurous that there were stories of his intimidating or physically attacking opponents. He was very strict and serious in nature that even his sons never dared to speak in his presence. In order to maintain his status and public respect and to achieve his desired objectives he did not hesitate to spend lavishly even by selling his landed properties. Also he dared to go to the extent of even disposing of his considerable gold stock for winning a civil court case. It is said he urged his father in his youth to buy for him an elephant. Because of his spending mood and broad lavishness he became bankrupt. A diary was kept by him for entering several important incidents such as the date of birth of his grand children, important events, and ayurvedic medicines for certain complicated diseases etc. Married Aley from Cherikattusseril family, Chennamkary, Alappuzha District. She died at the age of 43 of typhoid. Children: Four sons and two daughters. Kunju expired 1943.

III A4 f MARIAMMA

Sent in marriage to Kuriyikkattu family, Pampady, Kottayam.

III A5 f THRESIAMMA

Sent in marriage to Pananthottathil family, Kottangal, Manimala.

III A6 f ROSAMMA

Sent in marriage to the family of Kandamkeril, Market, Changanacherry.

Sent in marriage to Puthenveettil family, Kurumbanadom.

III A1 B1 CHERIAN (Kanianchira Kutty)

Born 1901. Residence: family house at Vezhakkattuchira. Being the only son of his father, he inherited a lot of wealth as land, paddy fields, and moveable properties, gold, household materials and accessories etc. He was mainly a farmer. As Kutty died very young, Rosamma his wife belonging to Nangachiveettil family, Kainakary had to look after all the family affairs. She was extraordinarily bold, daring, and clever to look after all the family affairs. Their family house at Vezhakkattuchira, having a traditional outlook with old fashioned ara, pura and extended verandha and a beautiful garden in front remained as such a historic monument until it was recently destroyed in a fire accident.

It may be noted that at the eastern side wall of the verandha, a beautiful basin was installed inside the wall for keeping holy water and just above this basin a Marthomma cross made of cement. Several famous classical paintings related to Christian faith adorned the front walls. Children: Five sons only. Kutty died in 1941.

Sent in marriage to Kollavarathu family, Paippad, Changancherry.

Sent in marriage to Kodukuthiyil family (Srambickal), Muttar.

III A2 B1 CHERIACHAN

Residence at Mammoodu - Farmer - A gigantic figure with a strong physique - a well known gymnast, well versed in martial arts. Married Mariam, Koippuram family, Chettipuzha, Kurisummoodu. Children: One daughter only. Expired 1954.

III A2 B2 f ROSAMMA (Pennamma)

Married to Adv. Dominic, Karipparambil family, Kanjirappally. A famous and eminent person with 22 children in two marriages and Rosamma was his first wife.

III A2 B3 ANTHONICHAN

Aged 86. Shifted to Edayirikkapuzha from Changancherry. He was a big land owner and efficient farmer - tall and healthy in physique - hard working - Married Anna, daughter of Kunjappichan, Kadamthodu, Changanacherry. Children: Three sons and five daughters. Expired 30.10.1982.

III A2 B4 SCARIA (Kunjachan -otherwise known as Thekkumkattil Kunjachan) Residence at Mammood, a farmer - also business in hill produce. He had a well built physique - Married Philomina, daughter of Kuruvilla, Kunnamkerikalathil, Pallikoottummel. Children: Two sons and six daughters. Expired 22.5.1960.

III A2 B5 JOSEPH (Appachan)

Residence at Mammood - a farmer - very daring, challenging, and a courageous person. Married Mariakkutty, daughter of Chackochan, Kanjikkal (Prayikkalam), Pulincunnoo. Children: Two sons and one daughter. Expired 31.5.1962.

III A2 B6 CHACKOCHAN

Born 1903. Residence at Varakunnel, Mammood. A farmer - a man of spirituality - a member of Vincent de Paul charitable society. Married Katherine (Oromma), daughter of Josephkunj, Thekkekara, Kannavatta. Children: Two sons and two daughters. Expired 29.11.2001. Oromma expired on 10.1.1995.

Married to Kariachan, Mukkattukunnel, Kurumbanadam.

Married to Pilochoan, Vadakkekkalathil, Alappuzha.

III A3 B1 JOSEPH (Outhachan)

Born 1894. He shifted his residence from Morkulangara to Chethipuzha where there were many pieces of family property. In partnership with his brother-in-law he undertook enormous kopra business by amassing lakhs of coconuts from Changanacherry and surrounding areas. Being the eldest son of a big family having large scale cultivation and allied activities, he had to take up family responsibilities very early in life. Hence, he led a type of hard and difficult life. He was very calm and quiet in nature. He was very strict and very honest in all his

dealings. Never showed any kind of aggressiveness. He had always been very deep in Christian faith. He married Rosamma, daughter of Joseph, Illickal House (Mavelikkalam), Vezhapra, Kuttanad. Children: Five sons. Expired on 18.1.1989 at the age of 95.

III A3 B2 ANTONY (Kochappachan)

Born 1896. Shifted from Morkulangara to Chethipuzha where he had six acres of land in one block. A farmer - ran some other businesses - very smart. He seemed always very neat and fashionable in dress. He had good looks. He proved himself an expert in floating on deep waters. Married Mariamma, daughter of Joseph, Mukkattu House (Parambil), Market, Changanacherry. Children: Five sons and two daughters. Expired in 1954.

III A3 B3 THOMACHAN

Education ESLC. Born 1898. He was an employee in a company in Bombay at the time of the first world war. He happened to die there in an accident at the age of 25. He was very meek, calm and quiet in life. He was unmarried.

III A3 B4 CHACKOCHAN

Resided in the family house at Morkulangara. But after selling his properties there, he shifted his residence to Chethipuzha, purchasing a new plot there, to establish access to the families of his elder brothers. He did business in grocery. Married Accamma, Panackamattam, Niranam. Expired in 1958 in his middle age. Children: Two sons and three daughters. The eldest son and two elder daughters died in their childhood.

III A3 B5 f MARIAMMA

Married to Chackochan, Velloor house, Kainakary, Kuttanadu.

III A3 B6 f ALEYKOCH

Married to Kuncheria, Kochupurackal family, Kavalam.

III A1 B1 C1 KARIACHAN

He first resided at Poovakkatuchira by the side of the M.C. Road. For fear of Municipal acquisition, he sold that plot and shifted his residence to Ruby Nagar in a newly built modern house. He had wholesale business of jaggery in the market, Changanacherry. Since his death, the business is being continued by his sons. He was very meek, cordial, and lovable. He paid much attention to his family problems in general. He had a great affinity to Kudumbayogam. He married Aleyamma, daughter of Chacko, Kumbluvelil (Elapumkal), Nedumkunnam. Children: Four sons and four daughters. Expired 5.5.1996.

III A1 B1 C2 ANTHONICHAN

. He changed his residence from the family house to Varakunnel, Mammoodu, where he had purchased some rubber plantations. He was a gigantic person having more than six feet height and very strong and healthy physique. An expert in gymnastics and martial arts - well known for throwing knife with great

precision - very courageous and daring. If called for he was not reluctant to physically attack his opponents. Several such events were heard of in collaboration with one of his cousins of his type in the family, say, Kunjuvareechan; he has faced many threats against the family. Both of them were well known for their heroism in martial arts. He married Thresiamma, daughter of Chacko Mathai, Puthiyakunnel House, Kappad, Pala. Children: Three sons and two daughters. Expired 1968..

III A1 B1 C3 APPAICHAN

Very gigantic person. Died very young at the age of 20. Unmarried.

III A1 B1 C4 GEORGEKUTTY

Born 1929. Intermediate. Residence at Mammoodu in a newly purchased plot with a modern type of house. He shifted his residence to Kallar, Nedumkandom, with family for a long period for the convenience of practising homeopathy, running cinema theatre, and for looking after his plantations. Later his family returned to Mammoodu for the sake of Children's education. He married Thankamma, daughter of Kuruvilla, Amirampallil house, at Kallooppa. Children: One son and one daughter. Expired 1981.

III A1 B1 C5 JAMESKUTTY

Born 7.11.1934. Qualification M.A. He took his post graduate degree in economics from Agra University. A gigantic person of more than six feet tall, very strong in physique, outstanding in gymnastics and sports items as javelin throw, discus throw, shotput and hammer throw. He was Kerala University champion in the above four sports items. In collegiate and inter collegiate sports competitions he was the flag bearer in the march-past. As he did not get a suitable job, (he aspired, to say, a high post in the police department) he turned his attention to the business of chitty and financing on a large scale. He was a good farmer also. He was keeping high level friendship in the social and political spheres. Once he was elected to the position of Municipal Counsellor, Changanacherry. He was meek and large hearted that he used to face everyone with a pleasing smile. Always there was an expression of nobility in his face. Cheating or treachery was never part of his character. But he was not to tolerate treachery or cheating. He led a courageous and fearless life. There was no word, cowardice in his dictionary. He roared against insults and attacks like a lion, but it was not at the expense of propriety. The surrounding society without creed or caste accepted him as their leader. Many approached him for getting their different problems solved. He was an authority in taking decisions.

As far as Kudumbayogam (family assembly) is concerned, he took the initiative with Antony Marattukalam (Swapna Thankachan) to organize and restart the Kudumbayogam in 1975. They functioned as the warf and woof of it. He took much pains for its restoration. He served as its founder secretary and later president. His service to the Kudumbayogam was exemplary and praiseworthy that he gave encouragement and proper guidance to it. He was chronic bachelor. Owing to an accidental injury in the stomach he expired in 1984. His untimely departure at a younger age was a great loss to the family and to the society around.

Born 22.11.1927. SSLC and TTC. Residence at Edayirikkapuzha, Kangazha. Retired as a primary school teacher in 1983. Now a farmer. He took special interest in the activities of the Kudumbayogam. Married Thresiamma (SSLC & TTC), daughter of Jacob Thomas, Kuttantharappel family, Kadaplamattom. She retired as a primary teacher in 1984. Children: Three sons and one daughter.

He never refrained from political and social activities. For a period he was elected to the position of a Panchayath President in the Thrikkalanguodu panchayath, Mancheri. He married Annamma (SSLC), Perumcherrymanil house, Vaipur. Children: Three sons and two daughters. Expired on 13.10.2006.

III A2 B4 C6 SCARIA (Kariachan)

Born 2.4.1940. Education: B.A. Residence at Mamood. He has worked in the company of Saudi Aramco, Saudi, for a period of eight years. He inherited acres of land and on return from Aramco he changed his career to that of a rubber planter. Besides, he started private banking business. Moreover, he joined several partnership businesses. From all these sources he achieved sound financial stability. Simultaneously he reconstructed his family house into a two floor grand building with all modern facilities. It was one of his hobbies to rear different varieties of dogs in his family compound. He was very stout and strong in physique. In his school and college days he came out with flying colours in sports and gymnastics. He was university champion in hammer throw and discus throw, short put, and a record holder in hammer throw. He was an excellent rifle shooter. A number of fire arms are still kept well arranged in his show case. He possessed all India membership in associations like The Rifle Club, the Rotary Club, and the Gymnastic Club. He was an outstanding body builder and was adjudged 'MISTER KERALA'. He participated several times in the Mr. India competition and won the third place once. Because of his body build he acted in a film as a stunt artist. He married Mariamma (Monamma), (B.Sc Nursing and Dietician), daughter of Itty Iype, Edakkattu house, Kottayam. Monamma was working in the Saudi Aramco, Dhahran, as nurse for many years. Children: Two daughters only. Expired on 27.7.2005.

He is an expert in farming. He has been partner in several business enterprises including fishing boats. It is amazing to point out that he is an expert in carpentry. He possesses several modern carpentry tools - making fashionable household furniture as his hobby - We see in his house several such furniture. He is highly intellectual, capable of different strategies, and a practical genius. Apart from all other indoor games including playing of cards, and etc. he is very much interested in playing chess. He keeps wide- spread friendship. He has been a good teacher and an orator. He is one of the founder members of the renewed Kudumbayogam. He was its President and Vice President. He married Marykutty, daughter of Abraham, Mattappallil house, Ayerkunnam. Children: One son and six daughters.

III A2 B5 C3 JAMES (Chackochan)

Born 8.9.1935. SSLC, TTC, and drawing-cum-physical education. Residence at Mammood. Retired as a drawing-cum-physical education teacher in 1990 March from St. Peters High School, Kurumbanadam. Even after his retirement he was often called by the management for conducting inter-school level sports competitions organized by the management. He has conducted annual sports competitions organized by the Kudumbayogam. He is an expert farmer and very hard working. He has served the Kudumbayogam as Treasurer, Committee Member, and etc. He has a good circle of friendship. Married Annamma (SSLC and TTC), daughter of Devasia, Peediyakkal house, Ayyappankovil, Kattappana. She retired as primary school teacher from St. Shantals' High School, Mammood in May 1990. Children: One son and two daughters.

III A3 B1 C1 JOSEPH (Babychen)

Born 1926. Residence at family house at Chethipuzha. Was an accountant in the Ruby Rubber Works Ltd. But was compelled to resign his job for personal reasons. Then he practiced as a sales tax consultant in favour of several merchants at the market, Changanacherry. A good farmer. Interested in playing basketball and badminton games – best basketball player and a member in the basketball team in the S.B.H.S. Changanacherry. The team won in the inter school competition several years. The team participated in several all Kerala basketball competitions and also in outside state competitions. In such competitions also, the team won prizes several times. He was very interested in social, political, and religious activities from his early days. He was a good organizer. He served as an altar boy and as a member of pious organizations like the Sodality, the St. Vincent de Paul Society, Social Action forum, etc. related to Sacred Heart Monastery, Chethipuzha. He was an actor too in social dramas at Chethipuzha. Kept very good friendship with others. A public figure in all respects.

He served the Kudumbayogam as its founder President, Secretary, and Treasurer on different occasions. Married Claramma, daughter of Varkey (Kuttichan), Vaniappurackal house, Edathua. Expired 20.4.2008.

III A3 B1 C2 MATHAI (Kurunnu)

Born 25.12.1933. M.A. Economics and M.A. in Religious Science MA, (RSc). Residence at Industrial Nagar, Changanacherry. He retired as a Superintendent from the Education Department in 1988. After retirement he took the MA(RSc) in Theology in the THIRD RANK from the Marthomma Vidaya Niketan, Archdiocese, Changanacherry. Groomed in social, religious and cultural activities from childhood in the atmosphere of the Sacred Heart Monastery, Chethipuzha under the guidance of famous seminary professors like Dr. Placid, Dr. John Brito, Fr. Clement, Dr. Januarius, Dr. Lucas and Dr. Canitius. He was a member of the famous organization, The Social Action Forum, Chethipuzha and was its President from 1965 to 1970, Fr. Felix, CMI, being its Director. The forum was famous for conducting social seminars, closed annual retreats, social and religious dramas, social celebrations, and etc. Also helped the starting of poultry farming in houses, constructing low cost "Baker Model" houses for the poor in the plots purchased by the organization. Selected a village and brought about its integrated development in collaboration with the C.S.U. units of St. Berchman's and Assumption Colleges. Funds collected by conducting benefit shows on a large scale with the help of great cinema stars and musicians as Yesudas, Jaichandran, and others.

By 1970, M.O. Mathai shifted his residence from the family house at Chethipuzha to Industrial Nagar, Veroor and began his activities as a Sunday school teacher in St. Joseph's church, Veroor. By 1976, the problem of carbon black pollution affecting the public and the nearby church, had grown to its zenith. Immediately a public agitation started against the factory owners. This agitation lasted for two years with interventions on the part of the government, civil courts, dharnas

before the factories, and etc. M.O. Mathai was one among the six member super committee elected for leading this agitation. About 12 civil court cases were handled by this committee. Sri M.O. Mathai had attended many government level conferences and civil court cases in this respect.

He was a Sunday school teacher for about 45 years, 20 years at Sacred Heart Church, Chethipuzha and 25 years at St. Joseph's Church, Veroor.
